New chapters like Aphthae, Black heads, Buttocks, Cellulitis, Chronic diseases, Crohn's disease, Erythema, Excitement of sexual desire, Osteoporosis, Pains, Sclerosis, Stress and Cancer related diseases like Lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease have been added. Many more illustrations are included. The bulk of the work and old headings stand as it were before. The author wishes to call special attention to the chapters of this work which are devoted to hygiene and dietetics. These subjects are primarily important. The homeopathic physician should believe in himself and his knowledge of remedies — this is his key to success.

PREFACE TO THE FIRST EDITION

'The Illustrated Guide to Homeopathic Treatment' has been specially written for the benefit of the students of homeopathy and laymen who want to treat their own diseases. Simple language and easy words have been used for easy understanding.

Illustrations are given where necessary. Diseases have been described for treatment in a non-boring way. This guide is useful as "Teacher's Notes" of practical homeopathic therapeutics. Remedies have been arranged alphabetically for sake of convenience. That is not all. This book will also be found useful by the homeopathic medical practitioners as being a short cut to the repertory of the homeopathic materia medica and for easy selection of a remedy.

No definite and scientific guide is available for the selection of a potency. Some practitioners use high potencies with success while others use low potencies with satisfactory results. I use high potencies in chronic cases and low in acute and recent cases. I consider 30C potency neither low nor high. Thus selection of a potency is a matter of one's own choice and experience. In this book, where Q is mentioned against a remedy, it means mother tincture, where X is mentioned beside the potency, it means potency in decimal scale and where neither of these two are mentioned, it means potency in the centesimal scale and where no potency is mentioned, it means 30 in this scale.

It will be agreed that diseases like death, old age, etc. (about 10% in all) are not curable. Likewise, all the diseases cannot be cured by oral medicines alone. Surgery is required in some cases like fracture of bones, etc. I have given methods of surgery employed by surgeons in some cases because questions about it are generally asked by students as well as patients. Machines like X-rays, ultrasound, scan or magnetic resonance imaging unit (M.R.I), etc, are used in surgical cases and also in some other cases. M.R.I. gives incredible snap shots of the body for detection of bone marrow illness, disorders of ligaments and cartilages and their injuries. It also detects tumors and nervous disorders.

Microscopic and other laboratory tests are useful in their own way like examination of stools for the presence and kind of worms, urine for presence of casts, etc. and blood for its disorders. Use of machines makes it easier for the homeopath to treat the diseases and save the patient from surgery in several cases. It is very important that the cause of disease be known so that, the treatment can be directed at the source of the problem.

Our life depends upon the diet taken. Useful suggestions as to what can be taken and what should not be taken during ailments are given in each chapter. Medical science is a continuous process of study and research. Results of latest studies and research, as collected from various journals and newspapers are incorporated to keep the homeopaths abreast of the latest developments. I hope that this multipurpose book will be found useful by laymen, students, teachers of homeopathy, homeopathic medical practitioners, researchers and all those who love homeopathy.



ABORTION PRODUCING

Several countries have laws that make it illegal to cause an abortion in the healthy females. The following course can be tried only when the continuing of the pregnancy can cause damage to the health of the patient or to the baby when born and that also, keeping in view the law of the land. The course must be taken no later than 9th week after the start of last menstruation.

1. **Gossypium Q + Macrotinum Q** - mixed in equal quantity and given in 40 drops a dose, *thrice daily causes abortion within five days*. If it does not occur in five days, wait for five more days before trying the *second course*. More than two courses are not advisable. Stop the treatment when the bleeding starts.

2. Carica papaya Q induces abortion when locally applied to the mouth of the uterus. It causes the cervix to soften and dilate, and the uterus to contract, expelling the fetus.

NOTE: Both the treatments should be given simultaneously.





It is useful in the abscess near the ear. It is also useful in case of abscess in lungs. In 2x or 3x potency, it hastens suppuration and 1M or 10M potency checks suppuration. **Mercurius sol.** (tds) : If the pus has formed and the abscess is taking a septic form. The skin becomes bluish. Myristica seb. (tds) : It often acts better and powerfully in the opening of an abscess. It is known as a homeopathic knife. Very effective for abscess at the end of fingers and phalanges. **Pyrogenium** 1M (hs) : Recurring abscess, fever and septic conditions are cured by the use of this remedy. Repeat after 1 week Rhus tox. (tds) : Abscess near the arm pit or the parotid gland. Pus is mixed with blood. It is useful for suppurating glands. Pus is thin, copious and corroding. Ripens abscess and promotes its suppuration. Silicea (tds) It helps to heal a boil which is of an obstinate nature : Use it in the case of an abscess in the lumbar Staphysagria 200 (od) region. **Symphytum off.** 1M (hs) : After amputation of any part of the body or a Repeat every 3rd day limb, if an abscess is formed on the remaining part. Tarentula cub. 200 (od) : It is almost specific for an abscess in the armpit. One dose reduces the pain and either opens up the abscess when it is very ripe or aborts it.

: If the abscess is septic with yellow thick pus, use Calendula 30 internally and Calendula Q

mixed with warm water for washing.

Boils, herpes and blood poisoning.

Hepar also acts likewise in such cases.

ABUSIVENESS

Anacardium ori. (tds) : Tendency to use violent, abusive language.

ACIDITY (HEARTBURN)

Heartburn is substernal (behind the chest bone) pain and burning, usually associated with a reflux of gastric juices into the esophagus.

Acidum sulph. (tds) : Chronic acidity. Burning in esophagus.

NOTE: To avoid acidity:

- 1. Do not lie down soon after eating.
- 2. If overweight, lose weight.
- 3. Do not smoke or cut down smoking.
- 4. Avoid fatty and spicy foods, alcohol and foods containing caffeine.
- 5. In general, fruits and vegetables are alkali producing foods.
- A cup full of cold milk without sugar taken during the attack, gives immediate but temporary relief.

ACNE

(PIMPLES AND BLOTCHES)

Acne is an inflammatory disease of sebaceous (oil) glands. During puberty, sex hormones speed up the secretion of oil from these glands. Problems begin where there is a build up of oil in the narrow gland openings or drainage passages in the skin. It is, therefore, important that the perspiration and other coatings clogging the skin pores be washed off. Acne should not be squeezed as it leads to inflammation and scarring.

Four main types of acne are:

- a. White Heads: Round white blemishes that form when hair follicles become clogged.
- b. **Black Heads:** Round, dark blemishes that form when white heads reach the skin's surface and touch air.
- c. **Pimples:** Red, swollen bumps that form when plugged follicle walls break near the skin's surface.
- d. **Deep Cysts:** Pimples filled with pus that form when plugged follicle walls break deep within the skin.



ACNE FACE LOTION

1. Take 5 ml each of **Berberis aq.** Q, **Ledum pal.** Q **Echinacea** Q and **Bellis per.** Q. Mix all the four with 20 ml of water if skin is oily. In case of dry skin, use mustard oil instead of water. Rub on the face which has previously been washed with soap and water, and dried. It improves the complexion also. Mustard oil contains Rhodallin which dissolves scar tissue.


It is a very useful lotion and may obviate necessity for using any other medicine orally.



2. Put raw egg yolk on the face and let it dry for 10 minutes. Then wash with soap and water. Doing this for a month causes disappearance of acne and lesions.

Egg yolks are an excellent source of vitamin A which has been used for years for treatment of acne. Vitamin A is also present in milk, butter and liver.

ADENOIDS



Hypertrophy of the adenoid tissue (pharyngeal tonsil) that normally exists in the nasopharynx of children.

Agraphis nutans 3x (tds)

NOTE: Following treatment cures most of the cases of adenoids:

1: Start the treatment with Bacillinum 200 - one dose. No medicine for the next 24 hours.

2: After 24 hours, give 2 doses of Agraphis nutans 3x and 2 doses of Calcarea phos. 6x, alternately.

3: To facilitate breathing at night, the use of the following mixture will prove useful: Hydrastis Q = 1ml to be mixed with 6ml of glycerine. A cotton plug drenched in this mixture should be inserted in each nostril for 15 minutes and then removed.

ADRENALITIS

(INFLAMMATION OF ADRENAL GLANDS)

Adrenal gland is a triangular-shaped body adjacent to and covering the upper surface of each kidney and secrete a group of hormones. When the secretion of hormones is high, it results in hypertention and increase of urine volume and when it is low it causes anemia, sluggishness, weakness, weight loss, hypotension, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and mental changes. When such a deficiency is chronic, it is called Addison's disease.

The cause may be hemorrhage in the gland as a result of infection and it may occur at birth resulting from an injury. The following remedies may be found useful, but the selection of the remedy should be made on the totality of symptoms.

Adrenalinum 2x, 3x

: By stimulating sympathic nerve endings, it controls hypertension. It checks capillary hemorrhage, nausea and vomiting. There is a sensation of constriction of chest and thorax.

Argentum nit.


: It improves the memory and reduces bad mental impules, fear and habit of doing things in haste

Arsenicum alb.

: Its use removes mental fear and anxiety, nausea and vomiting. Helpful in the cure of anemia, specially when there is iron deficiency.

Iodium 2x

: The atrophy and inflammation of the adrenal glands is removed by the use of this remedy by arousing the immune system of the body.



AIDS

(ACQUIRED IMMUNO-DEFICIENCY SYNDROME



Common AIDS associated diseases and sites.

No case with this label has ever come to me. It is possible that a patient not properly diagonised and who was unaware of the disease may have come to me. A homeopath treats the diseases on its symptoms only. It is possible that such a patient may have been treated by me on its symptoms. Since the vital force of the patient is rendered deficient and the patient is unable to defend himself against diseases, the following medicines can prove useful taking into account the symptoms.

The following remedies may be used alongwith the indicated remedy of the disease of the patient.

Camphora (tds)

: The patient presents a picture of collapse. The body is icy cold. Strength appears sinking. Pulse is small and weak. Repeated drop doses

of Camphora Q on a lump of sugar will strengthen the heart and raise his vital force. He will be able to fight the disease. The medicine can be repeated every 5 minutes till the condition of the patient improves.

Carbo veg. (tds)

: Vital force nearly exhausted. The disease has greatly depleted the patient. He cannot recover from it, and has cold copious sweat, cold breath, cold tongue and loss of voice. The patient appears to be in the last stages of life. In such cases, this remedy may save the life.

Echinacea Q (tds) 10 drops in ½ cup of water : It is a great stimulant of the immune system. Maybe used with confidence in conditions of abnormal state of blood, blood poisoning and septic conditions. The patient has the tendency of malignancy in acute and subacute disorders. It increases the WBC count and enhances the macrophage function which destroys foreign invaders in the body.

Iodium (tds)

: It arouses the defensive apparatus of the system by assembling the mononuclear leucocytes.

Laurocerasus Q 10 drops in ½ cup of water Lack of reaction in chest, heart and lung affections.

Lobelia purp. (tds)

: Overwhelming drowsiness as produced by the bite of a snake. Intense prostration. Cannot keep eyes open. Vital force becomes very weak with a feeling of paralysis of the body, heart and lungs. Intense chill without shivering.

Silicea 6x (tds)

: It strengthens the vital and defensive forces. The patient is chilly and likes to keep the head covered. It cures deep-seated diseases and is useful in the cure of AIDS.

Tuberculinum 200 (hs) Repeat after 1 week

: AIDS patient has low or no recuperative powers. He is always tired. Motion causes intense fatigue. Medicines, even well indicated, fail to improve the health of the patient. Tuberculinum acts in such cases

- NOTE 1:AIDS is caused by H.I.V. (human immunodeficiency virus) which damages the body's immune system and nervous system and makes it susceptible to the opportunistic infections which would not be a threat to a healthy person.
- NOTE 2: It has been a mystery as to where the AIDS virus came from. It is believed that AIDS originated from Africa. Dr. Kevin Decock of USA who heads centres for disease control and prevention in Atlanta, Dr. Beatrice Hahn of the University of Albania along with Dr. David Ho and others from the Aaron Diamond AIDS Research Centre at Rockefeller University, New York have concluded that the AIDS virus originated from chimpanzees, first in Africa and then spread to the world. They stated it in a conference in Birmingham on 31-1-99.
- NOTE 3:AIDS is not a hereditary disease and is not caused by kissing or masturbating. There is a high risk of contacting H.I.V. by an anal or vaginal sex without using a condom.
- NOTE 4: A person cannot get infected by casual contact with an infected person (such as shaking hands),hugging or kissing, being coughed or sneezed upon, swimming in the pool, siting on a toilet seat and sharing beds, eating food in the same utensils and from insect or animal bite.
- NOTE 5: A study published late in the year 2004, revealed that worldwide 38 millions people were infected with H.I.V. and 20 million died from AIDS during that year.

AIR SICKNESS

Aconitum nap. (tds) : A person is afraid of travelling by air. A dose will remove his fear

Argentum nit. (tds) : It removes fear of air raids.

Arnica mont. (tds) : It prevents mental and physical fatigue after travel by air.

Belladonna (tds) : Give one dose as a preventive, 20 minutes before travelling by air and one dose immediately before boarding the plane.

Borax (tds)

: Use this when the stomach is upset or there is a fear when the plane descends to land. One or two doses of 30 potency will suffice.

Petroleum (tds) : If inspite of the above treatment there is ringing and cracking in the ears or heaviness in
